On Monday, October 30, 2017, at 2026 hours, I was dispatched to Meeker Road at Meeker Creek Drive on a reported traffic hazard. Dispatch said the unknown caller reported a light pole was down in the roadway.

I arrived at 2146 hours. I saw a trail of fluid that was coming to the south on Meeker Creek Road and proceeding westbound on Meeker Road. I pulled onto Meeker Creek Road and discovered that a light pole that is on the center median was knocked over, and the pole was gone. This is where the trail of fluid started.

I saw the glass from the pole light was on the ground under where the pole had been, and also in the roadway, to the north of the pole. I saw two pieces of the pole base, still in the median, but laying to the south of the pole location approximately 10 feet. I saw exposed electrical wires from the base of the pole, and contacted fire to check to see if this was an electrical hazard.

I investigated further, and approximately 50 yards to the north of the pole base, I found the pole, lying in the grass, on the east side of Meeker Creek Road. Approximately 20 to 30 feet further north from that, there were 2 other pieces of the pole base, also in the grass, north of the destroyed pole. I could see the concrete on the median, by the pole, had chunks missing, as if a vehicle had drove southbound on Meeker Creek Road, drove over the median, and continued driving south in the northbound lane, towards Meeker Road. This appears to be how the damage occurred to the vehicle, causing the fluid to leak.

The trail of fluid is suspected of being engine oil, possibly from the oil pan being damaged. I requested Officer Maples to respond and track the oil. The fire department arrived on scene and examined the wires and determined there was no power, or hazard present. Using their lights, I could see a spot, in the grass, on the east side of the road, near the pole and debris, which appeared to be tire marks, as if a vehicle drove into the grass. It was difficult to determine if this was from a motor vehicle, or a lawnmower, as there was several marks in the grass from a lawnmower.

Officer Maples tracked the oil trail, going westbound on Meeker Road, then going southbound onto Meeker Woods, and the trail stopped in front of a house at the dead end. There was a puddle of oil, but no other trail. It is suspected the vehicle had been towed, or trailered from that point. Officer Maples said he spoke to neighbors, who could not provide any information. Officer Maples also took photographs of the scene for me.

At this time, I am not sure what events happened during this crash. I can't determine what direction the suspect vehicle had been driving when the crash occurred due to the debris being scattered both directions, and the trail of oil going in the opposite direction. There are no witnesses or evidence at the scene to assist me.

I did learn that the pole is owned by the Meeker Creek Home Association, and there was a representative at the scene, aware of the damage. The representative left before I got his information. At this time, I request this case be suspended until leads are developed to pursue a suspect.

On Tuesday, October 31, 2017, Officer Naas apparently got a call from Sharon Studebaker, of 2421 Arbor Glen Court. She was reporting a crash concerning this accident, and he referred her to me. I received this information on 11-6-17 from Sergeant Bilbrey, who assigned me the follow up.

On Thursday, November 9, 2017, at approximately 1900 hours, I called and spoke to Ms. Studebaker. She said that her husband had been driving on Meeker Road, then turned onto Meeker Creek Drive, and struck the light pole that was already knocked over in the road. She said the vehicle's radiator sustained damage because he had drug the pole for several feet before stopping. She said he was able to get it unstuck, but the radiator was leaking fluid.

This would explain how the pole and base parts got moved so far from the scene, to the north. She said he had pulled up onto the curb, into the grass area, to dislodge the pole. Since this was a second crash, I told her we would be out to take a report. I also learned they had taken the car to get repaired, and it is still in the shop. Officer Jackson will respond to their house and take a separate crash report. At this time, I still do not have any leads as to the original suspect who hit the pole, and left the oil trail.
