

# Butler Township Waste & Recycling Services

## WASTEGUIDELINES

- Trash and recyclables should be placed at the curb (no more than 10 feet from the road) by 6 a.m. on collection day.
- All trash should be contained in bags and trash cans. Rumpke trash carts are available to rent for \$3 per month.
- Rumpke will not collect paper barrels or drums of any size.
- Items may not weigh more than 60 pounds.
- Bulky items are collected on trash day. Appliances containing freon require special handling. Please wrap upholstered items for the health and safety of workers. Please call Rumpke and specify items that should be collected.
- Yard waste is collected with trash. Brush placed at the curb must be tied in bundles no larger than four feet long and two feet wide.
- Dead animals, tires, paint, auto or mechanical fluids, auto parts more than 50 lbs. or gas cylinders should not be put in the trash. Montgomery County Solid Waste District (937) 225-4999 provides disposal options for household hazardous waste.
- Rocks, dirt or construction debris should not be put in the trash. Rumpke (800) 223-3960 has construction containers available for rent.

## OPTIONALTRASHCART

Residents may use their own garbage cans if they are no larger than 32-gallons each, or residents can rent a large trash cart (95-gallon wheeled cart with a lid) from Rumpke.

- Trash carts are available for rent for \$3 per month.
- Payable 6 months in advance (\$18).

## RECYCLINGGUIDELINES

- Rumpke provides each residence a large recycling cart, which is collected every-other-week (see collection calendar).
- Items acceptable for recycling include paper, plastic bottles and jugs, aluminum and metal cans, glass bottles and jars and cardboard. Please see the reverse side for examples.
- Items unacceptable for recycling include plastic bags, metal hangers and medical sharps.
- Recyclables are sorted at Rumpke Recycling and sent to manufacturers as a raw material for new products.
